Dear Laconia School District Community,


Earlier today, Governor Chris Sununu announced that public school buildings will be closed for the remainder of this school year. That means that remote learning will continue in the Laconia School District and in schools around the state.

Our leadership team, staff, and School Board have been working to prepare in anticipation of this announcement. On Tuesday, April 21, the School Board will vote on a proposal to continue remote learning through April Vacation so that we can end school earlier. We are working with the school community so that we can recognize our students in our year-end celebrations. These celebrations may have to look different than they have in the past because of local, state, and/or national guidelines due to COVID-19, but it is important that we continue to work together with our families to recognize our students in a way that they deserve. We will update you as we receive more information.

Even though this news was expected, we understand that this official news is disappointing for our school community. During the period of remote learning, I have often said, "One more day of schools being closed is one day closer to our schools opening." Though this will not happen this year, we will continue to work to support our staff, students and families this year and look forward to our schools opening in the future.
