Dear Laconia High School Staff and Families.


Our varsity boys' basketball played a basketball game at Hollis-Brookline High School on Tuesday, March 10th. Though our team boys lost in overtime in this playoff game, I was proud of how hard they played and how such a large crowd of Laconia fans supported our student-athletes.

The school community at Hollis-Brookline received communication from their Superintendent about a family who was "advised by their medical professionals to self-quarantine based on recent travel to major US cities in New England and the demonstration of symptoms (of COVID-19) by a parent." He also stated, "The children have participated in school and extracurricular activities at Hollis-Brookline High School until this time."

In light of the recent news about the virus, I wanted to make you aware of this communication. Though there is no confirmed case at the school, it is an example of medical professionals recommending self-quarantine as a precautionary measure. We have had no reports of anyone at the event who is exhibiting symptoms, but will continue keep the lines of communication open with our staff and students so that we can respond if necessary.
