
This "Grab-and-Go" system will follow a very simple process. Students can Grab and Go at a bus or school stop at the time designated on the attached document and pick up their meals from a bus that will provide this service Monday through Friday. You can Grab and Go at any bus stop or any school in the district. If you miss a bus stop or if you choose to pick-up meals at Woodland Heights, be sure to get their between 1:00 and 2:00pm.

On Monday through Thursday, the school district will provide a breakfast and lunch. On Fridays, the district will do the same and Got Lunch! will provide additional meals for the weekend as well. We are very appreciative of the amazing community support our students receive from these outstanding community partners.
