

# Pleasant Street School

## Breakfast, Snack and Lunch

- Breakfast:
  - Approximately 8:40 am, breakfast will be delivered to the students in their classrooms by the cafeteria staff. Lunch orders will be collected at this time.
- Snack:
  - Approximately 9:30 am, healthy snacks will be delivered to the students in their classrooms by the cafeteria staff.
- Lunch:
  - Based on supervision, we currently will have two lunches. Lunches will be served to the student in their classrooms by PSS staff. Currently teachers will be eating lunch with their students in the room.
    - 11:45 am: Grades 1, 2 and 3 will have lunches delivered
    - 12:15 pm: Grades k, 4 and 5 will have lunches delivered

## Student Movement Plans:

We have only two (2) hallways at PSS so movement is limited regardless of the plan

- All student/staff movement will remain the same (i.e. right side, second white square) throughout the building.
- Student and staff will be required to wear face masks when moving throughout the building.
- We will have specific signs (i.e. outside of the main office) to control the number of students in a space
- Group bathrooms are limited to two (2) students at a time due to physical distance and supervision.
- Art will be taught in the classroom while Physical Education will be outside if weather is acceptable.

## Entrance/Exit Plans:

Pleasant Street has three (3) specific entrances/exits we will be using.

- Kindergarten Entrance/Exit (pink arrow on attached map)
  - AM Entrance: Students in grades K – 3 use this entrance in the morning. The students are lined up and sent into the school individually from the basketball courts.
  - Recess: Students in grades K-3 will use this entrance and exit when participating in recess.
- Fifth Grade Entrance/Exit (yellow arrow on attached map)

- AM Entrance: Students in grades 4-5 will use this entrance when arriving at school in the morning
- Recess: Students in grades 4-5 will use this entrance and exit when participating in recess
- PM Dismissal: Students in grades 4-5 will use this exit when leaving school for the day
- Main Entrance (light blue arrow on the attached map)
  - AM Entrance: All students who arrive late (after AM bell) will use this entrance when arriving at school.
  - PM Dismissal: Students in grades K-3 will use this exit when leaving school for the day

## Dismissal Plan:

We will be using our “rainy day” dismissal plan for all students. All students remain in their classroom until called.

- Staff communicates with a designated person (usually the principal) of the family that is in pickup line. That designee announces over the intercom system that the students ride is here. That student leaves out of the specific grade level exit, wearing their mask, to their vehicle.
- When a bus arrives, we dismiss the bus students as a group, and they exit out of their specific grade level door.
- Walking parents will have wait on the sidewalk, maintaining physical distance (marked with paws). They will communicate with the designee who will announce their child’s name and that student will exit out their specific grade level door.

## Traffic Pattern

As in the past, the traffic pattern on Pleasant Street is as follows:

- All traffic enters on the right side of the building (it is one way)
- Cars travel to Aubrey Lane and turn around, so all traffic is facing and entering in one direction.
- Once students are picked up, they exit PSS and can go in either direction.
